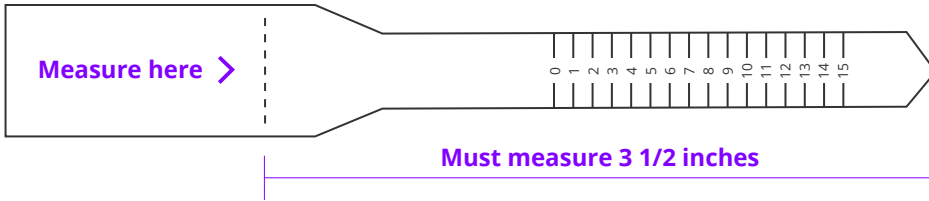


RING SIZE GUIDE



HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Option 1

1. Print out this Ring Size Guide and carefully cut out the measuring strip on the left. Cut a small slit along the dotted line.
2. Wrap the strip around the base of the intended finger that you will wear the ring.
3. Pull the pointed end of the strip through the slit snugly to see your ring size.

Option 2

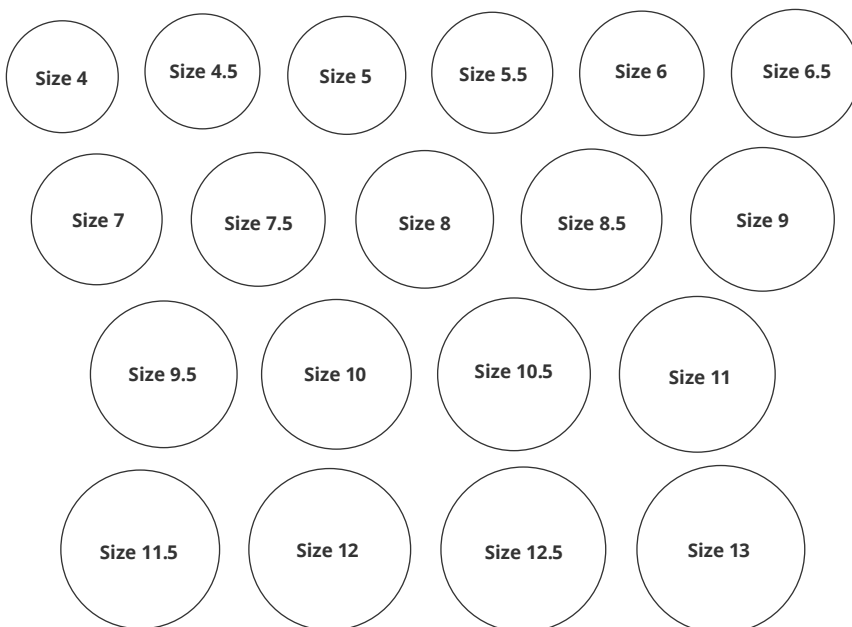
1. Wrap a string around the base of the intended ring finger like you will wear the ring.
2. Mark the string where it meets, and measure the length with a ruler.
3. Use the chart at left to determine your ring size.

Option 3

1. Print out this ring sizing guide (be sure that the PDF is set to print at 100%).
2. Place a ring that you or the intended recipient wears over the circles to the left. Find the circle that lines up with the inside of the ring.

TIPS

- Measure your finger toward the end of the day and when your hands are warm.
- Rings should fit comfortably snug so they do not slide around or off.
- For wider bands or cocktail rings, go 1/2 a size larger, as they tend to have a tighter fit.
- Your dominant hand (lefty or righty) tends to size larger.
